Recent Developments

The Company registered an aggregate of 1,588,564 shares of Common Stock issuable upon conversion of 5% convertible promissory notes on behalf of Revere Investments LP. (“Revere”). On October 30, 2017, the Company affected a 4-1 reverse stock split. All numbers in this Supplement reflect such reverse stock split. On September 5, 2017, Deane A. Gilliam converted her promissory note to 175,000 shares of Common Stock. On October 31, 2017, Deane A. Gilliam transferred the Common Stock to the Deane A. Gilliam 2017 Irrevocable Family Trust. Accordingly, the Selling Stockholders section in the Prospectus is amended to replace Deane A. Gilliam as the Selling Stockholder with the Deane A. Gilliam 2017 Irrevocable Family Trust. Ari Raskas exercises sole voting and dispositive power over the Deane A. Gilliam 2017 Irrevocable Family Trust and thus is deemed to beneficially own
